1. The Bus Links to Big Sky Resort
(Need to look at schedule times and to plan and work it out with your arrival and departure times.)
When you get to Gallatin Field Airport in Bozeman, call Greater Valley Taxi at 406/587-6303, to get you from the airport to the first part of the bus ride. It is 2-3 miles and will cost approximately \$11-16 depending on how many in taxi. The rest of the bus links all the way to the resort are free, paid by resort tax and local subsidy. Have the **taxi** take you to **Rocky Mountain Supply** in Belgrade, where you will get out and wait for the bus line. This first bus line is the city line, which is called Streamline Bus (www.streamlinebus.com 406/587-2434). Use website to get bus schedules. Take this local bus, to the Gallatin Valley Mall (Food Court), a little strip mall, where the resort bus line, called the **Skyline Bus Co.** and take the **LINK EXPRESS**, the **GREEN LINE route**, and it will pick you up, according to their schedule. (www.skylinebus.com 406/995-6287). This bus link will take you all the way to the bottom of the mountain of the resort, where it will transfer you to a bus that takes people just up the mountain. Everyone gets to the transfer point at the same time and waits, so you can't miss it. It will take you up the mountain to the door of the Big Sky Resort.
You just need to print out the schedules above, and see how the bus schedules work with your arrival and departure schedules.

Note: On the Streamline bus route, the schedule starts at **Rocky Mountain Supply**, and you get off at the **Gallatin Valley Mall by Food Court**.
On the Skyline bus route, the Link Express, the name of the stop is **Gallatin Valley Mall (Food Court)** and you continue and get off at **Hungry Moose-Route 1 Transfer** from Link (this is near Big Sky). Here is where it transfers you to the local bus that takes you right up the mountain to Big Sky Resort's door, which is listed as **Mountain Village Center** on the schedule. When you print out the schedule, you will see these names and see the point-to- point destinations with their pickup times.

1st person \$140
For persons 2, 3, and 4, just \$5 each additional.
Groups of 5-14, \$40 per person.
So if you have several people arriving close by in arrival/departure times, you can share these costs.
3. Rent a car
Hotwire.com and priceline.com are about best options.
4. Barbara is doing **limited scheduled/reserved shuttle runs**. She can be reached at 972/768-8319. The fee is if only one person in van, \$33. If more than one person, \$25 each. This is a one way fare.
5. Drive your own vehicle and help ride-share with others.
